
Step 1

Verify machine does not either start or increase to high rpm from base and platform controls. Once verified proceed to next step.

Step 2

Locate LP mixer mounted just before throttle body. (refer to the figure to the right)

Once located, loosen hose clamp and pull mixer and intake assembly away from throttle body, exposing the throttle body inlet to atmosphere.





Step 3

After step 2, start machine and check for high idle. If engine operates properly replace or rebuild (some units are not repairable) the LP mixer. Once replaced verify proper operation.
